ORDER

No. ZPS-49 / 12.2. / 2021

Pursuant to Art. 25, item 1, Art. 100, item 2, and Art. 127 of the Regulations of the University of Forestry, in accordance with Orders No. ПД-01-74/01.02.2021, No. ПД-01-20/15.01.2021, No. ПД-01-718/18.12.2020, and No. ПД-01-677/25.11.2020 of the Minister of Health, and in conjunction with Decision No. 72 of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Bulgaria of 26 January 2021 for extending the term of the emergency epidemic situation, announced by the Decision No. 325 of the Council of Ministers of 14 May 2020, extended by the Decision No. 378 of the Council of Ministers of 12 June 2020, Decision No. 418 of the Council of Ministers of 25 June 2020, Decision No. 482 of the Council of Ministers of 15 July 2020, Decision No. 525 of the Council of Ministers of 30 July 2020, Decision No. 609 of the Council of Ministers of 28 August 2020, Decision No. 673 of the Council of Ministers of 25 September 2020, and Decision No. 855 of the Council of Ministers of 25 November 2020, and following a proposal made by the Chief State Health Inspector in order to reduce the spread of COVID-19, I enact the following measures:

1. Full-time students shall pay the semester fees by **bank transfers** and enroll for the summer semester of the academic year 2020/2021 by **February 26, 2021**.

2. The educational process shall start in absentia on February 22, 2021, in an electronic learning environment, and continue in accordance with the current orders issued by the Minister of Health and the Rector of the University of Forestry, related to the anti-epidemic measures.

3. The distance learning in an electronic environment shall be carried out synchronously in accordance with the weekly training programmes through the Office 365 applications (Teams, Forms, etc.) or other electronic platforms, including Blackboard. The lecturers shall present the topics in accordance with the calendar plan in teaching hours as included in the weekly training programmes. Additional instructions, provision of training materials, assignments, consultations, etc., shall be provided without overlapping with the weekly training programmes of the students.

4. Instructions on the terms and conditions of enrollment and conducting the training shall be published on the website of the University of Forestry by February 15, 2021.

5. The weekly training programmes for conducting the classes during the summer semester shall be published on the website of the University of Forestry by February 19, 2021.

The present order shall be brought to the attention of the full-time students; lecturers; Vice-Rectors of Educational Activities and Accreditation, International Integration and Public Relations; Deans and inspectors of faculties; Chief Accountant; Council of the University of Forestry.

The control over the execution of this order is assigned to Prof. Milko Milev, PhD, the Vice Rector of Educational Activities.
